## Volunteers Needed for Mind & Memory Changes Study Consider participating in research to help Stanford neuroscientists understand mind & memory changes in Parkinson's disease.

We are recruiting individuals with Parkinson's disease, Dementia with Lewy bodies, and healthy volunteers.

Study participation includes:

- 1 day or 1.5 days in-person visit at Stanford.
- <u>Assessments</u>: neurological exams, neuropsychology testing, a blood sample, gait & balance tests, collecting cerebrospinal fluid (optional), and collecting PET/MRI scans (optional)
- This is a <u>longitudinal study</u> looking at Parkinson's disease over time. You will be <u>contacted once per year</u> by phone or visit at Stanford.

You will be given a parking and lunch voucher, \$200 if you agree to a lumbar puncture collecting cerebrospinal fluid, and \$100 for a PET/MRI scan.
